Breeding Show

Open class sheep may not arrive before 8a.m., Sunday, Sept. 19

Entries in place by 4p.m. Sunday, Sept. 19

Romney, Natural Colored & All Other Wool Breeds Show 8a.m. Tuesday, Sept.

21. Remaining Breeds Show 8a.m. Wednesday, Sept. 22

*All open class animals will be released Wednesday, Sept. 22,
at 8p.m. and must be out by 10p.m.*

Rules & Regulations:

1. The sheep show is open to all, irrespective of residence.
2. An entry of \$5 per entry is payable when entry is made. Pass policy can be found in the rules & regulations.
3. No deductions will be made from any premiums awarded.
4. All sheep must be representative of the breed and properly fitted to be shown.
5. Shropshires and Southdowns must be sheared no sooner than 10 days before the show.
6. Exhibitors are limited to only one entry per group class.
7. All animals must be registered in the owner's name 30 days before the show.
8. All premium checks will be mailed to exhibitors.
9. Refer to general rules and regulations for additional information.

Natural Colored

1. Classes will be the same as the purebred categories.
2. Sheep must have at least 35% colored fleece. No white sheep shown.
3. Sheep will be judged 60% for hand spinning fleece quality, 40% body conformation and soundness.
4. Sheep are not to be washed, clipped or blocked so as not to damage the wool.
5. Dung locks may be trimmed.
