Judging at 9 a.m., Monday, Sept. 15

Additional Rules and Regulations:

1. Youth turkey exhibitors must be present for judging.
2. There will be no farm flocks, and no classes for trios.
3. Premiums will be awarded to all varieties of poultry recognized in the standard of perfection, and ornamental varieties as well as non-standard breeds and varieties recognized distinctly as such by the superintendent.
4. Poultry exhibitors must comply with the Maryland Department of Agriculture Health Requirements for Poultry. Please refer to the first section of the fair catalog or visit <https://mda.maryland.gov/AnimalHealth/pages/fairs-shows.aspx>.
5. During exhibition, all specimens will be under the control of the superintendent and cannot be removed without authorization. A poultry technician will be on hand to make daily inspection of all birds on exhibition. Any bird showing signs of sickness or disease will be removed from the poultry barn.
6. The term "specimen" Implies anything for which a premium is offered. The cock and hen are specimens hatched prior to 2025; cockerel and pullet are specimens hatched during 2025.
7. Any exhibits left in the building after 9 a.m., Sunday, Sept. 21 will be done so at the owner's risk.
8. Exhibitors are limited to 2 entries per variety, per breed for each class (for ex. 2 Barred Rock Hen, 2 Barred Rock Pullet, 2 White Rock Hen, etc.) with the exception of meat turkeys which you may only enter one.
9. Meat turkeys - Min. weight to be eligible for the livestock sale is 29lbs for toms and 21 lbs for hens. Any meat turkey weighing less than 20 lb (toms) and 15lbs (hens) will not be shown and may be sent home at the discretion of the superintendents.
10. The same type of egg may not be entered in more than one class. Eggs must be from youth exhibitors own flock.

Divisions will be all breeds and varieties listed in alphabetical order.

Exhibitors are limited to two entries per class per variety.
