Rules & Regulations:

1. Classes will be judged in accordance with the rules and regulations in the current AOA Show Committee Handbook.
2. Exhibitors meeting with judge at 7:30 a.m., Friday, September 19th
3. Showmanship and Obstacle events will be held on Friday, Public Relations, Costume Contest, and handlers' choice classes will be held on Saturday, September 20th at 9:30 a.m.
4. All exhibitors must have an ID card into the Fair office (4-H acceptable) by July 1 of current year.
5. All camelid exhibitors who do not own their own animal must have a signed lease agreement into the Fair office by July 1 of current year.
6. Show attire is the youth fair shirt provided for current year and jeans (no holes). All animals will be housed as directed by the superintendent. Pen assignments will be given during arrival times and must be followed (no exceptions). Exhibitors must remain in their assigned pens.
