### DIVISION 1 – ART

#### Rules & Regulations:

- 1. See "General Rules and Regulations" for a complete list.
- 2. All artwork MUST be surface mounted and centered on clean solid black standard photo mat board or foam board. Tag or poster are NOT acceptable. DO NOT USE OVERLAY MATS. All artwork must be securely mounted to a mat or foam board. Use rubber cement or permanent spray adhesive. Framing is discouraged. No entries with glass will be accepted.
- 3. All work must be ready to hang! NOTE: When selecting picture hangers for artwork, please consider the weight, size, and type of artwork and the fact that artwork may be hung on pegboard. DO NOT use duct tape or paperclips to hang for display.
- 4. Original artwork is not copied. Your own photographs are excellent resource material. Copyrighted material (i.e., cartoon characters) will not be accepted.
- 5. Wet paintings, obscene or questionable artwork are unacceptable.

(*Supports canvas, primed wood, or pasteboard*)
- 2. Acrylic Painting (*Supports canvas, panels, cardboard, illustration board, & paper - NO construction paper*)
- 3. Watercolor Painting - Original  
(*No Tempera or poster paint here*)
- 4. Poster Paint or Tempera
- 5. Calligraphy
- 6. Pencil Drawing
- 7. Pen & Ink Drawing  
(*Supports – paper not sized*)
- 8. Pastel Drawing - No Crayon (*Supports paper, pasteboard, or specially prepared fabric*)
- 9. Crayon Drawing - Only Crayon
- 10. Charcoal Drawing (*Supports soft-fine grained paper; use a fixative*)
- 11. Scratchboard - Original
- 12. Mixed Media Drawing (*Supports paper, canvas, or plaster primed wood base*)
