Rules & Regulations:

- See “General Rules and Regulations” for a complete list.
- All collections must be mounted and secured.
- All items in Divisions 3 (Ag Collection), 4 (Elec. Work), 5 (Woodworking), 6 (Metal), and 7 (Misc.) must be usable. Non-usable items will not be accepted. **Exception:** Division 4, Class 5 (Pictures) and Division 7, Class 4 (Taxidermy).
- All items in Division 4 (Elec. Work), 5 (Woodworking), 6 (Metal), and 7 (Misc.) must be accompanied by a plan, blueprint or drawing used in the construction of the item along with a statement of the intended use. **Exception:** Division 4, Class 4 (Pictures)
- Large items may not be displayed at the discretion of the building superintendents.
- See each division for additional rules.

DIVISION 1 – FORESTRY

Rules & Regulations:

- Collections must include where the specimen was collected (i.e. leaf from maple tree, bark from white oak) as well as the state and region/county where collected.

DIVISION 2 – NATURE COLLECTIONS

Rules & Regulations:

1. Collections must include specimen common name as well as the state and region/county where collected. Scientific name is encouraged.

CLASS

1. Weed or Wildflower (*Booklet*) (*Vegetable, flower, or crop*)
2. Rock Collection, Minerals
3. Shell Collection
4. Seed/Pressed Flower Display
5. Misc. Nature Collection (*No Insects, All items found in nature. No collections of man made materials*)

DIVISION 3 – AGRICULTURAL COLLECTIONS

Rules & Regulations:

1. Entries must include a list of items for display.

CLASS

1. Companion Animal Collection (*Collection of items utilized to care for a companion animal*)
2. Livestock Collection (*Collection of items utilized to care for livestock*)

DIVISION 4 – ELECTRICAL WORK

CLASS

1. Electrical Games, Quizzes, etc.
2. Extension Cord, Drop Lights
3. Lamps - Original
4. Lamps – Kits
5. Pictures, Story (*Display on electrical improvements you have made on your farm, shop, or home*)

DIVISION 5 – WOODWORKING

Rules & Regulations:

1. Entries from kits with prefabricated items are considered crafts. See Department 4M (Crafts) for appropriate divisions and classes. **Exception:** Class 7 (Clocks)

CLASS

1. House or Feeder (*Bird, bat, or butterfly*)
2. Small Wooden Kitchen Items (*Cutting boards, napkin holder, etc.*)
3. Small Wooden Shop/Farm Articles (*Letter holders, key racks, frames, wall plaques, etc.*)
4. Small Wooden Toys
5. Wooden Lathe Work
6. Clocks (*Kit or Original*)
7. Small Furniture (*LD less than 22"*)
8. Large Furniture (*SD 22" or more*)
9. Small Refinished Article (*LD less than 22"*)
10. Large Refinished Article (*SD 22" or more*)

DIVISION 6 – METAL WORKING

CLASS

1. Forged Metal Items
2. Metal Items (*Welded or cut*)
3. Constructed Metal Item (*Non-welded*)

DIVISION 7 – MISCELLANEOUS PROJECT EXHIBITS

CLASS

1. Shop/Farm Articles Made from Rope/twine/paracord
2. Articles made from Metal/Wire
3. Articles Made with Combination (*Of wire, wood, rope, metal, etc.*)
4. Small Taxidermy Exhibits
