### CLASS

1. **Photographic Collection – One Year** (*A collection of photographs taken by the exhibitor since the previous Frederick Fair of at least 25 different insects in 5 or more orders. Each photograph should have a label which indicates where and when it was taken and the photographer's name and each insects should be identified to family*)
2. **Photographic Collection – Multi-Year** (*A collection of photographs taken by the exhibitor of at least 50 different insects (25 taken within the previous year) in 7 or more orders. Each photograph should have a label which indicates where and when it was taken and the photographer's name and each insects should be identified to family*)

### Rules & Regulations:

1. See "General Rules and Regulations" for a complete list.
2. All camera types are accepted – 35 mm, digital, etc. including cell phone.
3. The same photo CANNOT be entered as Black & White and Color.
4. Any Black & White photo enhanced with color will be considered a Color photo.
5. All photographs must be between 5"x7" & 8"x12" to allow cropping.
6. All photos are to be printed on photo paper.
7. Photographs must be SURFACE MOUNTED and CENTERED on CLEAN solid back standard WHITE 11"x14" photo mat board. Tag, Poster, or Foam Board are NOT acceptable. DO NOT USE OVERLAY MATS. The photograph must be securely mounted to the mat board. Use rubber cement or permanent spray adhesive. No tape of any kind, including scrapbooking tabs or art corners, are allowed. Photo mat board may be purchased at the local framing and craft stores.
8. Cut a white 3"x5" file card in half lengthwise to fit between the photo and lower right FRONT corner; attach to the mat board with rubber cement flush with corner edges with the following information on it (typed or printed):
  - Title of photograph
  - Type and name of camera or phone used
  - Date photograph was taken
  - Years' experience in photography
9. Your EXHIBITOR CARD is to be taped over the top to the FRONT upper right corner of the photo mat board.
10. No Hangers of any type on the back of the photograph.
11. No lettering on front of mount or photograph.
12. All photographs exhibited by Youth exhibitors at the Maryland State Fair, or any other competition MUST BE REMOUNTED for exhibition at The Great Frederick Fair in accordance with the above instructions.
13. Judging for photography exhibits:
  - a. Story Telling Ability – (30%)
  - b. The photograph is clear and sharp, and shows details in areas where appropriate few distracting elements (30%)
  - c. Photograph is mounted neatly and in accordance with requirements (30%)
  - d. The title is fitting and adds meaning to the photograph (10%)

### Rules & Regulations:

1. See "General Rules and Regulations" for a complete list.
2. All garments need to be pinned to a hanger. Garments must be entered on wire or plastic hangers with rotating hooks; plastic tube hangers are not allowed.
3. Entry tag should be securely pinned to each entry with a small safety pin.
4. If a commercial pattern is used, it is suggested that the guide sheet(s) should be brought to judging or be securely pinned to the garment. Please note any changes made to procedures suggested on pattern.
5. Exhibitors using their clothing for other fair events (i.e. livestock dress-up contests) must have advanced permission to remove their entry from the department or building superintendent. Exhibits may not leave the building until the day of the event and must be returned no later than 8:30 p.m. same day. Exhibitors may not remove the exhibits from their display location. The department or building superintendent will do that. Failure to comply may result in loss of ribbons/premiums.
