SHOW WILL BE HELD RAIN OR SHINE – ENTRY FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE

Rules & Regulations:

1. Refer to rules and regulations of general Fair for pass policy.
2. Entries close August 15. **No late entries will be accepted.**
3. Judges' decisions are final.
4. All horses and mules nine months or older must have proof of negative EAI/Coggins test within 12 months of the show date (i.e. – dated after September 15, 2024) Copy **MUST Accompany entry form.**
5. **As per Federal Law, All out of state livestock including horses and mules must have a CVI no more than 30 days prior (dated after 8/15/25) or a Global Vetlink Passport no more than 120 days prior (dated after 5/18/25) in order to participate.**
6. All animals exhibited in divisions 1-23, (classes 1 -75) must be registered with the appropriate breed association. You **MUST** send a copy of the registration papers with your entries, including Drum Horse Geldings with breed associations. Youth ages are determined by their age as of January 1, 2025.
7. Youth exhibitors 18 years, as of January 1 of current year may waive youth status and show as adults in hitch/cart classes and are not eligible for any youth classes.
8. Pee-Wee showmanship, class 107, must be accompanied by an experienced adult at all times when in the ring. Pee-Wee exhibitors must wear protective head gear.
9. Youth driving in classes 125, 126, 134 & 135 must be accompanied by an experienced adult driver.
10. Youth **MAY NOT** show, ride or drive Stallions. Exception: 2025 Stallion Foals and Mare & Foal classes.
11. Youth and Pee-Wee exhibitors must wear riding helmets in Under Saddle Classes.
12. Any stallion not being shown under control will be excused from the ring and will have to be housed on the trailer or removed from the Fairgrounds.
13. Senior showmanship is for exhibitors 65 years & older. The limited Mobility Showmanship class is for adults with restricted mobility. Showman will be asked to **WALK ONLY** with their horse/mule. Showman **CANNOT** show in both classes and are **NOT** allowed to

show in any other Halter classes (Mare, Mare & Foal, Stallion, Gelding or Mule).

14. The show committee reserves the right to divide, combine or cancel classes as numbers of entries warrant. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
15. The Great Frederick Fair, Inc. will not be responsible for accidents, damage, injury, or illness of the animals, owners, drivers, employees, attendants, spectators, or any other person or property in connection with The Great Frederick Fair Draft Horse and Mule Show.
16. Rules of courtesy must be obeyed at all times. Any act of discourtesy to judges or show officials on the part of owner, exhibitor, or groom will disqualify that entry and all entry fees and premiums will be forfeited.
17. Animals not in show condition or showing any lameness will be disqualified. All vehicles and harness must be in safe, useable condition.
18. Any owner, exhibitor or groom mistreating an animal will be barred from the show and all entry fees and premiums forfeited.
19. All use of alcohol or drugs is strictly forbidden. Anyone found using these substances before, during, or after the show will forfeit all premiums and will be removed from the Fairgrounds.
20. Dogs are not permitted on the grounds.

Dress Codes: The dress codes apply to all Draft Horse and Mule exhibitors includes driver and show ring assistants to the exhibitor.

Halter classes: Dress slacks, shirt or blouse, tie, and hat optional. No blue, faded or torn jeans. Proper footwear required. No T-shirts.

Hitch classes: **Gentlemen** – dress slacks, coat, tie, dress hat and proper footwear **is** mandatory. Proper footwear required. NO blue, faded or torn jeans.

Ladies – Long Dress or formal, long skirt with blouse, dress pantsuits and proper footwear. No blue, faded or torn jeans.

BREED CLASSES - ALL ANIMALS EXHIBITED IN THESE DIVISIONS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE APPROPRIATE BREED ASSOCIATION. SEND COPIES OF REGISTRATION WITH ENTRY FORM
