Show will be held rain or shine – entry fees are non-refundable

Rules & Regulations:

1. The show committee reserve the right to divide, combine, or cancel classes as numbers of entries warrant. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
2. The officers of The Great Frederick Fair, Inc. will not be responsible for accidents, damage, injury or illness of the animals, owners, drivers, employees, attendants, spectators, or any person or property in connection with The Great Frederick Fair Standardbred Horse Show.
3. Rules of courtesy must be obeyed at all times. Any act of courtesy to judges or show officials on the part of owner, exhibitor or groom will disqualify that entry and all fees and premiums will be forfeited.
4. Animals not in show condition or showing any lameness will be disqualified. All tack must be in safe usable condition.
5. Any owner, exhibitor, or groom mistreating an animal will be barred from the show and all entry fees and premiums forfeited.
6. Judges' decisions are final.
7. Dogs are not permitted on the grounds
8. All horses must have proof of negative Coggins test within 12 months of the show date (i.e., Dated after September 7, 2024). **Copy must accompany entry form.**
9. All animals must be registered Standardbreds. If not branded, owner/exhibitor must provide registration papers.
10. Youth exhibitors must be under 18 years of age.
11. All use of alcohol or drugs is strictly forbidden. Anyone found using these substances before, during or after the show will forfeit all premiums and will be removed from the grounds.
12. All classes will be judged by the Standardbred show judge.

Dress Code: No blue or faded jeans. No T-Shirts.

Approved Helmets must be worn when mounted.

Horses will be judged at a walk, and trot or pleasure gait both ways of the ring. Judged on manners, suitability, and condition.

Entry Fee - \$5.00 per class – Youth may show in any class.

Premiums – 1st - \$25 | 2nd - \$20 | 3rd - \$15 | 4th - \$10 | 5th - \$5

Champion - \$30 | Reserve Champion - \$20
