Additional Rules and Regulations:

1. Dairy Goats will follow American Dairy Goat Association Rules.
2. Tattoos will be checked upon entry. All dairy goats must be tattooed, and the tattoo must be readable. In the event a tattoo on an older doe is hard to read, microchips will be scanned. All tattoos must be healed and dry prior to entering the Fair.
3. All dairy goats will adhere to the milk out schedule to be posted and announced by the superintendents.
4. All dairy goats must have horns removed and completely healed before Fair.
5. Novice Showmanship - The Novice Showmanship class is only for those individuals who have been "Showing a Dairy Goat" for less than 12 months from the date of the current Great Frederick Fair Youth Dairy Goat Show. "Showing a Dairy Goat" is defined as showing/handling a Dairy Goat in a show ring during a competition (youth or open) in any county, in any state.
6. Exhibitors in the Bred & Owned class must be the breeder and the first and continuous owner of the animal being shown.
7. All animals shown in group classes must have been shown in individual age classes.
8. All dairy goats must have been owned or leased by the exhibitor before first freshening or before 2 years of age, whichever comes first.
9. Leased animals are acceptable. Leased animals must be assigned to the leasing exhibitor by July 1st of the current year and signed leasing paperwork on file at the GFF office.

1. Junior Kid (*Born after April 1st of current year*)
2. Intermediate Kid (*3/1 – 3/31 of current year*)
3. Senior Kid (*11/15 previous year – 2/28 of current year*)
4. Dry Yearling (*Under 2 years old, not in milk*)
5. Junior Champion (*Selected from class 1 - 4 winners*) – RIBBON ONLY
6. Reserve Junior Champion – RIBBON ONLY
7. Junior Get of Sire (*3 does under 2 years, same sire, not in milk*)
8. Junior Best 3 Females (*3 does under 2 years, not in milk – 1 exhibitor*)
9. Best Junior Doe of Show
10. Milking Yearlings
11. Doe in Milk, 2 Years & Under 3 Years
12. Doe in Milk, 3 Years & Under 4 Years
13. Doe in Milk, 4 Years & Under 5 Years
14. Doe in Milk, 5 Years & Older
15. Senior Champion (*Selected from class 10 - 14 winners*) – RIBBON ONLY
16. Reserve Senior Champion – RIBBON ONLY

DIVISION 10 – EDUCATIONAL EXHIBITS
