4. No Lego and/or model entries will be accepted.
5. All items must be this year’s work.
6. All small crafts should be mounted on a foam board or cardboard base.

DIVISION 1 – FUNCTIONAL CRAFTS

1. Class 2 - For sewn dolls, see 4W (Home Furnishing & Family Life) for appropriate divisions and classes.
2. Class 3 - For all store bought flowers (silk & real) please see 4Y (Flowers) for appropriate divisions and classes.

Rules & Regulations:

1. See “General Rules and Regulations” for a complete list.
2. All collections must be mounted and secured.
3. All items in Divisions 2 (Ag Collection), 3 (Elec. Work), 4 (Woodworking), 5 (Metal), and 6 (Misc.) and 7 (Digital Fabrication) must be usable. Non-usable items will not be accepted. **Exception:** Division 3, Class 5 (Pictures) and Division 6, Class 4 (Taxidermy).
4. All items in Division 3 (Elec. Work), 4 (Woodworking), 5 (Metal), and 6 (Misc.) and 7 (Digital Fabrication) must be accompanied by a plan, blueprint or drawing used in the construction of the item along with a statement of the intended use. Items not accompanied by written documentation must be conference judged. **Exception:** Division 3, Class 4 (Pictures)
5. Large items may not be displayed at the discretion of the building superintendents.

DIVISION 1 – NATURE & FORESTRY COLLECTIONS

Rules & Regulations:

1. Collections must include the specimens common name, as well as the state and region/county where collected. Scientific names are encouraged.
2. Leaf and bark collections must also include the tree species from which the specimen was collected (i.e. leaf from sugar maple, bark from white oak).
3. Collections are expected to grow year over year. Returning exhibitors should demonstrate additions or improvements to previously exhibited collections.

CLASS

1. Leaf Collection (10 or more specimens)
2. Leaf Collection (25 or more specimens, may include specimens from class 1)
3. Leaf Collection (35 or more specimens, may include specimens from class 1 and 2)
4. Bark Collection (10 or more specimens)
5. Bark Collection (25 or more specimens, may include specimens from class 4)
6. Fruit & Nut Collection (15 or more specimens)
7. Weed or Wildflower (Booklet)
8. Rock Collection, Minerals
9. Shell Collection
10. Seed/Pressed Flower Display (*Vegetable, flower, or crop*)
11. Misc. Nature Collection (No insects, all itmes found in nature. No collections of man-made materials)
