DIVISION 1 – SOAP MAKING

Rules & Regulations:

1. See “General Rules and Regulations” for a complete list.
2. All Soaps must be handmade by the youth exhibitor (may be done under the supervision of an adult).
3. Entries in classes 3,4,5,6 & 7 may use non-standard molds.
4. Entries in class 6 should include a list of all botanical materials used.
5. Entries in class 7 should include a list of all organic materials used.
6. Entries in class 8 must be in a box, basket, or other suitable container with products displayed. Display must fit 18in x 30in cellophane bag (bag will be provided).

CLASS

1. Handmade Soap (*single bar cut from a loaf mold or a bar from an individual bar mold*)
2. Soap with embedded designs (*free-form embeds, column or other formed embeds, or a combination*)
3. Swirled Soap
4. Layered Soap
5. Botanical Soap (*plant materials only*)
6. Soap with organic materials (*coffee grounds, oatmeal, poppy seeds, sand, etc.*)
7. Soap dough creations
8. Collection of handmade soap products in a decorative display (*bath bombs, lip balm, liquid hand soap, lotion, body scrub, etc.*)

DIVISION 2 – CANDLE MAKING

Rules & Regulations:

1. See “General Rules and Regulations” for a complete list.
2. Only solid wax candles may be submitted; no liquid-type candles will be accepted.
3. Candles must be made by the youth exhibitor (may be done with the supervision of an adult).
4. Candles must have at least 1 wick.
5. Entries in class 5 must include a list of all botanical ingredients.
6. Entries in class 6 must include a description of materials used to form the candles and how it was done (i.e. using sand, dirt, sugar, crushed stone, eggshells, etc.)

CLASS

1. Layered Candle
2. Sculpted Candle
3. Hand Dipped Candle
4. Candles in decorative glass vessel
5. Candles with botanical ingredients
6. Candles formed using organic or other materials for a free-form shape
