DIVISION 6 – HORTICULTURE

Rules & Regulations:

1. Must have been in the care of the exhibitor for at least 4 months.
2. One fresh cut flower per container.
3. Type of plant (common name) must be provided. Display cases will be provided by the Youth Building upon entry of the department.
