Open class sheep may not arrive before 6 a.m., Sunday, Sept. 20

Entries must in place by 12 p.m. noon, Sunday, Sept. 20

Romney, Natural Colored & All Other Wool Breeds Show 9 a.m., Tuesday, Sept. 22

Remaining Breeds Show 9 a.m., Wednesday, Sept. 23

All open class animals will be released Wednesday, Sept. 23, at 8 p.m. and must be out by 10 p.m.

Rules and Regulations:

1. Sheep shows are only open to Maryland Residents.
2. Pass policy can be found in the rules & regulations.
3. Exhibitors will need to purchase the number of pens they need to house their sheep. Each pen will cost \$25 and may hold a maximum number of 4 sheep per pen. Pens are limited and not guaranteed.
4. No entry fee deductions will be made from any premiums awarded.
5. All sheep must be representative of the breed and be properly fitted to be shown.
6. Shropshires and Southdowns must be sheared no sooner than 10 days before the show.
7. Exhibitors are limited to only one entry per group class.
8. All animals must be registered in the owner's name 30 days before the show.
9. Refer to general rules and regulations for additional information

Natural Colored:

1. Classes will be the same as the purebred categories.
2. Sheep must have at least 35% colored fleece. No white sheep shown.
3. Sheep will be judged 60% for hand spinning fleece quality, 40% body conformation and soundness.
4. Sheep are not to be washed, clipped, or blocked so as not to damage the wool.
5. Dung locks may be trimmed.

The Frederick County Sheep Breeders Association will present two Open Class Premier Exhibitor Awards, one for the Wool Breed and one for Meat Breed. The award is open to Frederick County residents, or Frederick County Sheep Breeder members. Exhibitors will show a flock of one breed of (five) sheep, using any combination of yearling rams/ewes and or ram/ewe lambs. Individual sheep must have been shown in respective breed show and be in the Exhibitor's name.
