Rules & Regulations:

1. The dairy goat show is open to all, irrespective of residence.
2. An entry fee of \$5 per entry, payable when entries are made. Refer to Fair Rules & Regulations for pass policy. No entry fee deductions will be made from premiums awarded.
3. Exhibitors must provide their own bedding and cleaning tools. Anyone that does not clean their pens will forfeit premiums.
4. American Dairy Goat Association (ADGA) official show rules govern. At time of arrival, all animals must be accompanied by registration, recordation or stamped ADGA, duplicate application for animals under six months of age.
5. Maryland or Interstate health papers are required for all animals. Original certificate must be in exhibitor's possession on the grounds upon arrival.
6. The Junior and Combined Dairy Goat Shows are separately sanctioned.
7. Permanent champions may be shown in the appropriate age class, or the Champion Challenge class but not both.
8. Substitutions may be made within the same breed and class and under the same exhibitor at check-in only.
9. Exhibitors must provide tattoo numbers on entry forms.
10. Age of animal is determined as of Sept. 26, 2026.
11. Exhibitors are expected to bring adequate handlers.
12. Refer to The Great Frederick Fair general rules and regulations for arrival/release times. Any exhibitor who removes animals without the permission of the Fair

Board or violates any other rules will be banned from future shows as will any animals registered in their name and may forfeit premiums.

- All animals will be housed in pens provided by the Fair. No animals will be allowed to be shown from the truck/trailer/vehicle unless instructed by fair official.
- Refer to general rules and regulations for additional information.
- Show order is subject to change to accommodate the flow of the show.**

- Dry Yearling (*Does under 2 yrs. of age, that have never freshened*)
- Junior Champion (*Chosen from first place winners in classes 1-4*) – RIBBON ONLY
- Reserve Junior Champion – RIBBON ONLY
- Junior Get of Sire (*3 does under 2 yrs. of age, not in milk*) Premiums: 1st - \$12|2nd - \$9|3rd - \$6
- Junior Best Three Females (*3 does under 2 yrs., not in milk. Bred by exhibitor*)
Premiums: 1st - \$12|2nd - \$9|3rd - \$6
- Produce of Dam (*2 does under 2 yrs., not in milk*) Premiums: 1st - \$12|2nd - \$9|3rd - \$6
- Best Junior Doe (*Selected from all winners of Class 5*) – RIBBON ONLY

- Dairy Herd (*3 does in milk*) Premiums: 1st - \$12|2nd - \$9|3rd - \$6
- Best Senior Doe in Show (*Chosen from all winners in class 8*) – RIBBON ONLY
